

HWR Program Kits

HWR has program kits available for leaders to borrow to help them complete achievements, electives, and beltloops. Kits contain stations, materials, and templates for activities, and include activities to complete all requirements, unless otherwise noted. A visit to Heckrodt Wetland Reserve or another nature center may be needed to complete the requirements. Many stations are designed as games to help scouts learn while having fun. A list of supplies and preparation steps is included in each kit. Leaders may need to make copies or provide craft supplies for the activities included.

Program Kits are available to leaders at no cost. A donation to HWR (a nonprofit organization) would be appreciated in exchange for use of our materials. Donations are used to replace kit materials that become worn, and to develop new kits.

Kits are available unless they are being used by HWR for scout clinics or they have already been loaned. Leaders must contact Tracey Koenig at least one week in advance and make an appointment to pick up the kits during regular operating hours (8 AM—4:30 PM Tuesday—Friday; 11 AM—4 PM Saturday and Sunday). Kits are loaned for 1 week and must be returned with all original materials included. Leaders not returning kits in complete and good condition will be invoiced for replacement materials.

Tiger Program Kits

Let's Go Outdoors

Stations to complete Achievement 5 (Let's Go Outdoors).. Also includes directions and templates to complete Elective 21 (the Show must go on), Elective 31 (Learn About Animals), Elective 35 (Fun Outside), and Elective 47 (Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle). Leaders will need to make copies and provide craft supplies (paper bags, glue, crayons, etc)

Making My Family Special

Stations to complete Achievement 1 (Making my Family Special). This kit must be used in conjunction with a visit to the Native American Teaching lodge at HWR (indoors or outdoors). Also includes directions and templates to complete Elective 6 (Song Time), Elective 7 (Play Along), Elective 14 (Reading Fun), and Elective 19 (Magic Trick). Leaders will need to make copies and provide craft supplies (paper, crayons, glue, paper towel cores, etc)

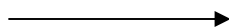


Wolf Program Kits

Bird Electives

Stations to complete Elective 13 (Birds), except f (build a birdhouse). Leaders will need to make copies and provide craft supplies (yarn, toilet paper cores, crayons, etc)

American Indian Lore Electives

Stations to complete Elective 10 (American Indian Lore). Includes stations, directions and templates to complete all parts of the elective. Leaders will need to make copies and provide craft supplies, (paper, paper plates, yarn, crayons,



Bear Program Kits

Sharing Your World With Wildlife

Stations to Complete Achievement 5a, c, d, and e (Sharing Your World with Wildlife). This kit includes a scavenger hunt guided hike that must be used at Heckrodt Wetland Reserve or another nature center. Includes stations, directions, and templates. Leaders will need to make copies and provide materials to make a poster.

Tying it All Up

Stations and directions to complete Achievement 22a, b, c, d, and e (Tying It All Up). Leaders will need to provide enough rope/twine for each scout to make a knot "board".

Tall Tales

Stations and directions to complete Achievement 4a, b, and c (Tall Tales). Leaders may want to assign scouts to find a folktale to read as part of this project.

American Indian Life

Templates and directions to complete Elective 24 a, b, and c. This kit must be used in conjunction with a visit to the native American Teaching Lodge at HWR (indoors or outdoors). Lead-

ers will need to make copies and provide craft supplies (craft sticks, markers, chenille stems, crayons, etc)



Webelos Program Kits

Forester Activity Badge

Stations and materials to complete the Webelos Forester Activity Badge (2, 3, 4, 5, 6). Includes hands on materials and poster templates. Leaders will need to make copies.

Naturalist Activity Badge

Stations and materials to complete the Webelos Naturalist Activity Badge (1, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 11). The kit can be used in conjunction with a visit to Heckrodt Wetland Reserve or other nature center. Leaders will need to make copies.

Geologist Activity Badge

Stations and materials to complete the Webelos Geologist Activity Badge (2,4, 5, 6, 7) Recommended that this kit be used in conjunction with a trip to the Weiss Earth Science Museum, although it is not required. An optional guided trail hike at HWR is also included. Leaders will need to make copies and provide markers or colored pencil.
